

How to set up Redemption rules in POS?

Before reward points can be redeemed, the Setup rules for reward points' redemption has to be established :

- For example, 1000 points = 50 SGD Loyalty Voucher valid for 2 months. If a customer has 1000 points, the cash register will offer to issue a 50SGD Loyalty voucher that will be printed when the customer makes the purchase.

Customer can use their loyalty voucher during payment
