



Redemption Points

4. Click on **"Revert"** button at the bottom of screen to roll back the changes


Delete Redemption Points Scheme

2. Click on **“Delete”** button at the bottom of screen


3. Click on **“Yes”** button on the pop-up window to confirm record deletion
