



Product Settings



This is also where user the Minimum Order Quantity and the Order Pack Quantity is also encoded. Below are available actions for the user from **“Product Setting”** :

Create New Product Setting

1. Click **“Create New”** button at the right side of screen

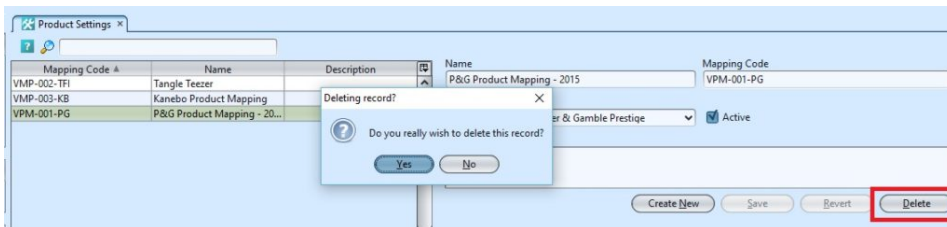

2. Click **“Save”** button at the right side of the screen when done with the updates

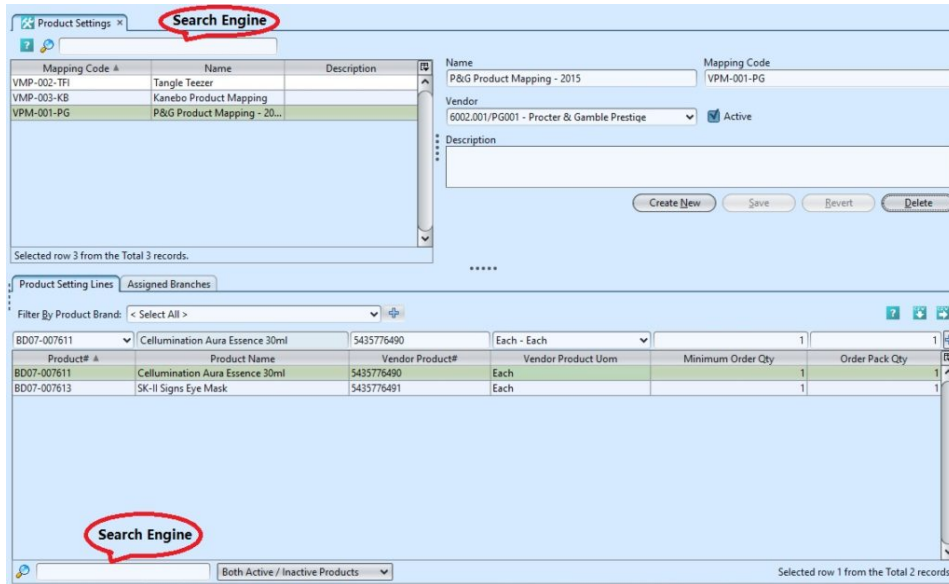
Delete Product Setting

1. Double click on product to be updated, it will bring up the selected product details on the right side of the screen
2. Click on **“Delete”** button at the right side of screen
3. Click on **“Yes”** button on the pop-up window to confirm deletion.

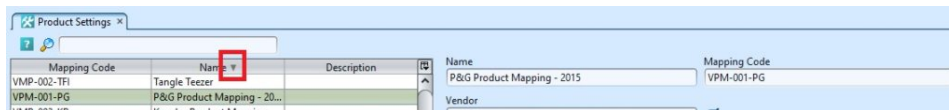


View and Search for Product Setting Details

1. Enter search parameter to filter the result, i.e. type in the product name in the search textfield box at the bottom left of the screen.



2. Result can be sorted alphabetically by clicking the fields' columns
